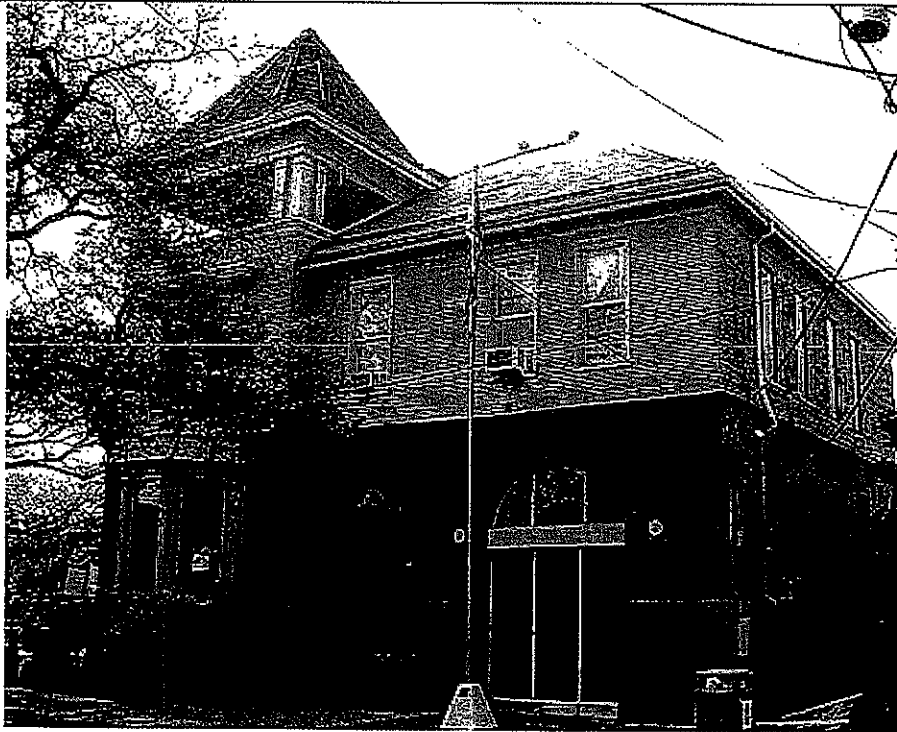

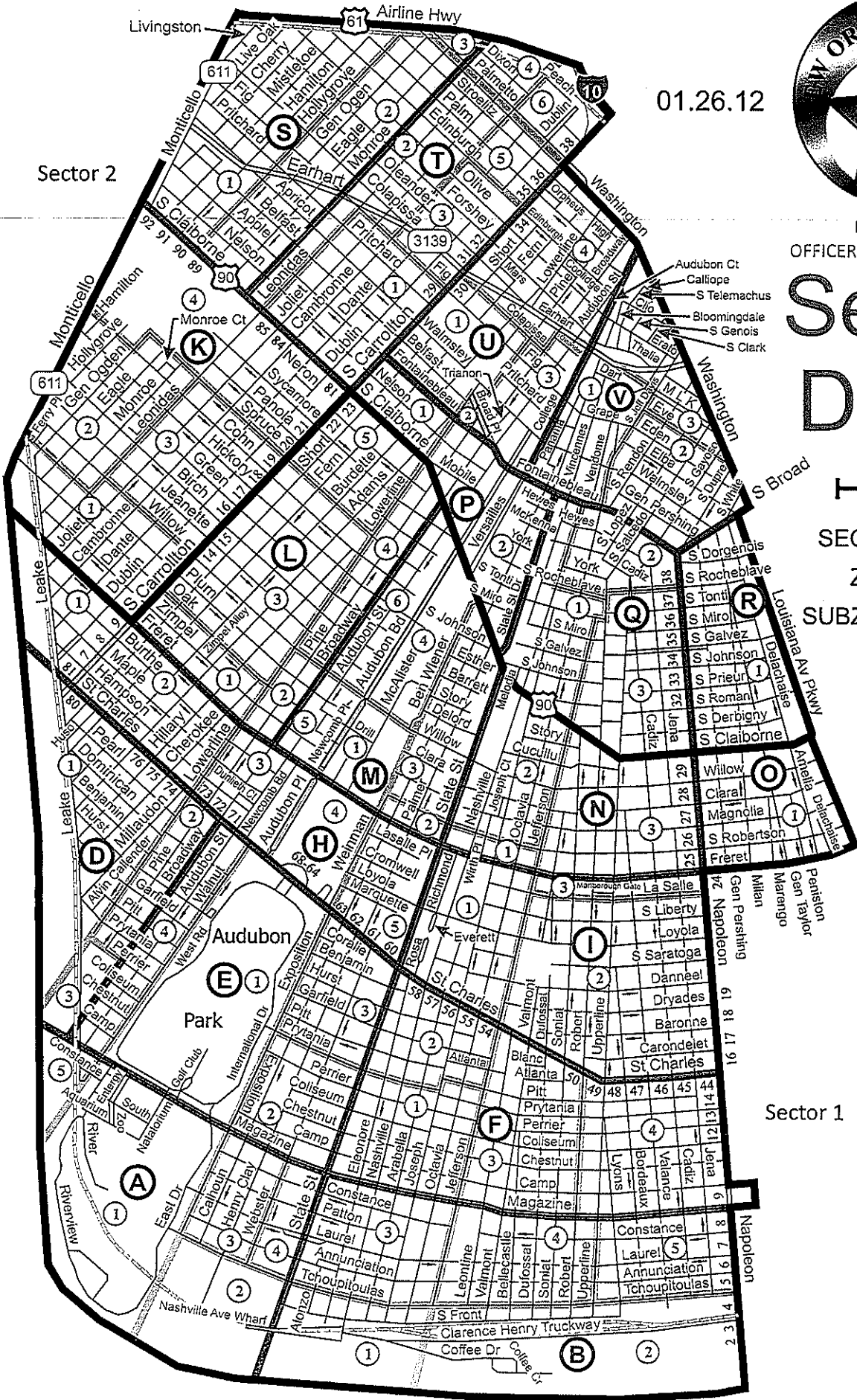

Crime trends for the Second district have been reviewed and analyzed for the period between 01-03-2016 and 04-30-2016

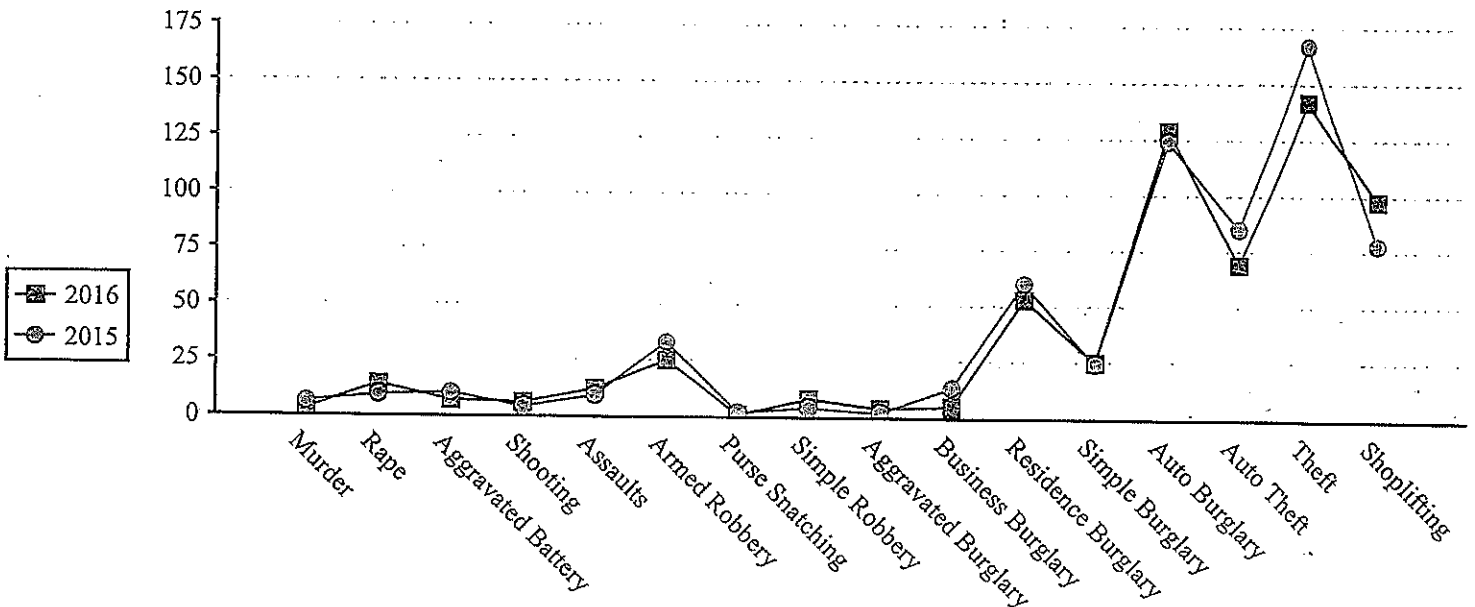
